

Infant Knitted Hat Pattern

Use #6 needles

Row 1: Cast on 88 stitches

Row 2: K2, P3 across until piece is 7 inches long

Row 3: K2 together across (44 stitches left)

Row 4: P across

Row 5: K2 together across (22 stitches left)

Row 6: P across

Row 7: K2 together across (11 stitches left)

Row 8: P across

End by running thread through last stitches on needle and pull together. Sew down the side to close the seam.

Pom-Pom (optional) – Hold thumb and forefinger about 2" apart, wrap yarn around them 50 times. Tie center of the loops with separate strand of yarn. Cut both ends of loop; shake pom-pom and trim any long strands so the pom-pom looks even. Tie securely to top of hat.
